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| Wednesday 12th September Write a book review; give a synopsis of the story, describe the main character, give a reason why you would recommend the book. | Choose a 3 digit number. Write facts about the number. Is it odd or even? What does it look like when it is partitioned? What is 10 more and less? What is 100 more and less? | Instant recall for multiplication and division facts for 2 and 5 times tables | Reading |
| Wednesday 19th September Describe your family members or pets using noun phrases (You will need adjectives and nouns) | Look around your home and find 5 different 3D objects. Name the shape they are and then describe its properties. Edges, faces, vertices. | Instant recall for multiplication and division facts for 3 and 6 times tables | Reading |
| Wednesday 26th September Write 3 sentences about events that have happened in the past. Write 3 sentences about things that you want to do in the future. Think about the tenses that you will use. | Create your own addition problems using 3 digit numbers. Then calculate them to find the answer. | Instant recall for multiplication and division facts for 10 times tables | Reading |
| Wednesday 3rd October Write a poem to describe your school. Think about what you see, feel and what you can do at school. | Pick 3 digits from 0-9. Make as many numbers as you can. Can you work out 100 more and less of each number? | Instant recall for multiplication and division facts for 4 and 8 times tables | Reading |
| Wednesday 10th October Write a letter to person of your choice tell about all the things that we do at school. Tell them what you like about school and one thing that you would improve. | Create your own subtraction problems using 3 digit numbers. Then calculate them to find the answer. | Instant recall for multiplication and division facts for 4 and 8 times tables | Reading |

Presentation - ensure you show your best presentation and effort in all your home learning.
